**Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Rijeka (University Campus at Trsat) on 30<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> May 2019**

The Workshop is aimed at gathering researchers at the early stages of their career, doctoral and postdoctoral students. Within the Workshop participants have the opportunity for further networking and presentation of research within a community of medievalists.

The Workshop is divided into two segments. The first part is reserved for presenting current research, while the emphasis of the second part will be placed on thematic workshops based on a specific field in medieval research. The co-located workshops are intended to provide a forum for researchers to address and exchange positions on a wide range of topics. These thematic workshops will be led by Croatian and international scholars - experts in the aforementioned fields. General intention is to present new methodologies in the research of various aspects of the Middle Ages.

#### **How to apply:**

##### **1. Individual papers:**

Speakers are asked to submit the title of the presentation and a short abstract (up to 500 words). Upon acceptance, the organizers assort the presentation within a thematically related session and provide a session chair.

##### **2. Thematic session:**

Several speakers can, according to their interests, organize and submit a session. The application must contain the title of the session, names of each speaker, titles of each presentation and a more elaborate abstract for the session (up to 1500 words).
